

February 11, 2008

Myron Amdahl called the regular meeting of the Wright County Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Olson, Amdahl, Toftey and Watne with Chelesvig absent.

Linda Klehm, Public Health Administrator updated the board that the Wright County Public Health Department was selected the top 25% in the United States of the top tier home health care agencies by the HomeCare Elite Organization. A public news release will be submitted to the local papers.

Approved minutes of February 4, 2008 meeting after some corrections were made.

Approve claims for payment.

Stephen Reitz, Wright County Engineer met with the board to update them about a bridge in Section #20 of Boone Township that has some structural problems. This is an old truss type bridge limited to three tons and on the National Register of Historic Places. The Engineer recommended that we close the bridge and not replace it.

It is a consensus by the board of supervisors to have the Engineer proceed with the temporary closing of this bridge and put it at the end of the 5 year plan.

Reitz also update the board about Sandy Beach Road at Lake Cornelia. The dips and ruts are back due to the freeze/thaw conditions. This could possibly cost in the area of \$500,000 to repair this small section of street. Funding of this project is going to be very difficult.

Ryan Brunner, Wellmark Blue Cross Blue Shield Account Representative met with the board and updated them on the reports of health insurance usage for Wright County. For the 2006-2007 fiscal year, Wright County usage rate was 1.32. This means that for every \$1.00 in premium paid we had \$1.32 in expenses. Ryan will come back with the dental rates when he gets those numbers.

Motion by Olson and seconded by Watne to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
