

April 30, 2018

Chairman Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present are Watne, Rasmussen, and Helgevold.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of April 23, 2018 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Jeremy Abbas, Assistant to the Engineer, presented the name of Marcus Spangler as the new Engineering Technician for the Secondary Roads department. Starting wage will be \$45,000 with an increase after successful completion of the necessary testing certificates. Motion by Watne and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the hire. Motion carries.

Abbas then presented Resolution 2018-24 on establishing temporary speed limits on various gravel roads due to Hwy 17 repair. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve Resolution 2018-24 on establishing temporary speed limits. By roll call votes: Ayes – Watne, Rasmussen, and Helgevold; nays – none. Resolution 2018-24 duly passes and reads as follows:

#### **RESOLUTION 2018-24**

##### **ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY SPEED LIMITS**

**LOCATION #1-Davis Ave from Eagle Grove South To 290<sup>th</sup>, Thence East to US 17**

**LOCATION #2-Calhoun Ave. from US 3 South to 265<sup>th</sup> St. West of Eagle Grove**

**LOCATION #3-Davis Ave. from South Goldfield city limits South to North Eagle Grove City Limits**

**LOCATION #4-Franklin Ave. from US 3 South to 265<sup>th</sup> St. (C-54)**

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.255 and 321.285(4), of the Code of Iowa, to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

**WHEREAS**, such investigation has been completed by the Wright County Engineer's Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Wright County Board of Supervisors that speed limit be established and appropriate signs erected at the locations described as follows:

1. **On Davis Ave South from Eagle Grove to 290<sup>th</sup> St, thence East to US 17**
  - A. 25 MPH from the intersection of Davis Ave. and South Eagle Grove City Limits South 1.5 miles to 290<sup>th</sup>, Thence East 1.25 miles to US 17
2. **On Calhoun Ave. from US 3 South to 265<sup>th</sup> St. West of Eagle Grove.**
  - A. 25 MPH from the intersection of US 3 and Calhoun Ave. South 4.75 miles to 265<sup>th</sup> St. West of Eagle Grove.
3. **On Davis Ave. from South Goldfield City Limits South to North Eagle Grove City Limits.**
  - A. 25 MPH from the intersection of South Goldfield city limits and Davis Ave. South 3.5 miles to the North side of the Eagle Grove city limits.
4. **On Franklin Ave. from US 3 South to 265<sup>th</sup> St. (C-54)**
  - A. 25 MPH from the intersection of US 3 and Franklin Ave. South 4.5 miles to 265<sup>th</sup> St. (county road C-54).

**This Resolution shall be in effect when the signs have been erected and shall be in effect for the duration of IDOT Project:**

Motion by Watne and seconded by Rasmussen to set the budget amendment hearing for May 21, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. for the Wright County FYE 2018. Motion carries unanimously.

Shari Plagge, Wright County Assessor, presented the Property Tax Exemptions for Slough Bills. There were 2,734 acres total with 17 acres of new applications and 13 acres cancelled. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve and have the Chairman sign the slough bill applications. Motion carries.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve the abatement orders #1149, #1150, #1151, and #1152 for Federal Government drainage assessment. Motion carries unanimously.

Received the Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center annual report and placed on file in the Auditor's office.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Rasmussen to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
