

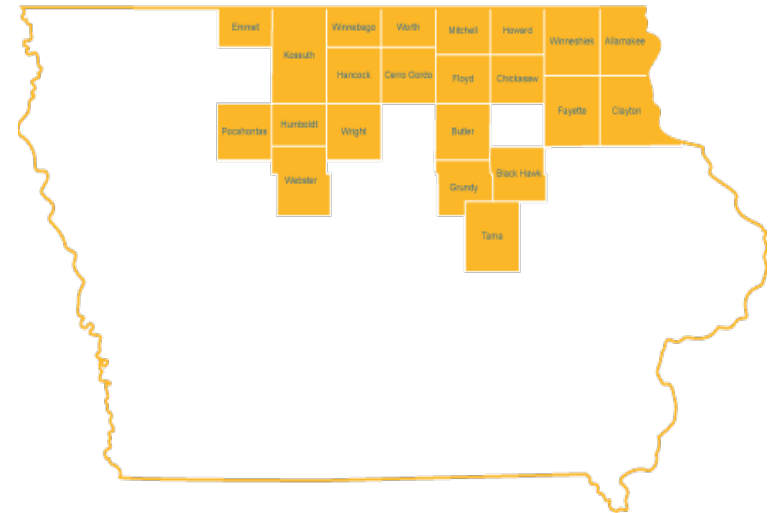

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Mental Health Program Eligibility

Purpose: The Mental Health Program helps you find and pay for mental health treatment.

- Have a diagnosis of Mental Illness
- Meet income guidelines
- No other payer

Three different ways to access mental health treatment:

1. Go directly to the nearest hospital or call 911 if you are concerned about hurting yourself or others.
2. Contact a Mental Health Center to schedule an appointment, their phone is answered 24/7.
3. If you would like to consult with a Service Coordinator or get funding for a private mental health provider call your local County Social Services office.

Disability Program Eligibility

Purpose: The Disability Program helps you find and pay for services to live successfully in the community with your disability.

- Have a diagnosis of Mental Illness, Developmental Disability, Intellectual Disability, Brain Injury or Co-Occurring disorder
- Meet income and resource guidelines
- Professional assessment of disability and need for service

Two different ways to access support funding:

1. Call your local County Social Services Office and schedule an intake interview.
2. Choose an agency to provide services and the agency will help you with the application process and scheduling an intake with County Social Services.
