Chairman Pro-Tem Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Kluss and Helgevold with Rasmussen absent.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of February 11, 2019 were read and approved after 2 changes.

Approved claims for payment.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevold to appoint Stewart Swanson to the Planning and Zoning board to replace Dean Kluss on this board. Motion carries.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevold to approve Resolution 2019-13 on the Compensation Board recommendation of 3% increase for the elected official's salaries. By roll call vote: Ayes – Kluss and Helgevold; nays none with Rasmussen absent. Resolution 2019-13 duly passes and reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION 2019-13**

WHEREAS, the Wright County Compensation Board meets annually to recommend a compensation schedule for elected officials for the fiscal year immediately following, in accordance with Iowa Code Chapters 331.905 and 331.907, and

WHEREAS, the Wright County Compensation Board met on January 29, 2019 and made the following salary recommendations for the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019:
