Chairman Rasmussen called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Kluss, Helgevold, and Rasmussen.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of February 19, 2019 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevold to approve the contract with ISG Engineering to do the Archaeological Services in the Agri-Business Park. Motion carries.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, presented an applicant's name for a new hire as a Heavy Equipment Operator – Sign Maintenance out of the Clarion Bridge shed. Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Kluss to approve the hire of Cody Poage in the Secondary Roads Department as a heavy equipment operator – sign maintenance employee. Motion carries.

Clemons gave an update of the road conditions in Wright County from the blizzard over the weekend. Also, an update of the Local Disaster Declaration that was put into place over the weekend due to the severe blizzard conditions.

Auditor Ellis read a letter received from Prestage Foods of Iowa in support of the sale of a lot in the Agri-Business Park to Ennis Transportation Services. In summary, Prestage is pleased to work closely with a local company that understands the refrigerated logistics business. It is also understood that Ennis is planning a maintenance facility along with a refrigerated truck washing operation. After some discussion, there was a motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevold to receive the signed letter of Intent for the sale of 10 acres of land in the Agri-Business Park to Ennis Transportation Services, Inc. Motion carries unanimously.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevold to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
