Chairman Rasmussen called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Kluss, Helgevold, and Rasmussen.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of July 15, 2019 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to appoint Tiffini Toliver as a Medical Investigator Deputy in Wright County. Motion Carries.

Denise Baker, Wright County Recorder, presented the quarterly revenue report. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to receive the quarterly revenue report from the Wright County Recorder. Motion carries.

In the afternoon, the Drainage Trustees of DD #117 met with interested landowners to gather information on a damaged tile. Dean Kluss explained the damages that were discovered in DD 117 Section 1 of Grant Township. Drainage Clerk, Courtney Stewart presented images that were filed in the auditor's office of this area showing the damages.

There were concerns from the landowners if an Open Ditch was established that there would be continuous maintenance on the ditch. One land owner voiced that the tile needed to be followed further up to where it starts as there is water flowing over the ground there as well. Through further discussion it was brought to light that DD 117 shares a common outlet with DD 19.

After further discussion, it was decided that an Engineer would be hired and a cap of \$5,000.00 would be placed to get options for the damaged area.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Kluss to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
