Chairman Rasmussen called the special meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 2:00 p.m. Members present were Kluss, Helgevold, and Rasmussen.

Other interested parties present were: Cindy Litwiller (Wright County Economic Development), Eric Simonson (Wright County Attorney), Sandy McGrath (City of Eagle Grove), Eric Gjersvik (ISG).

Representatives for the following companies were also present: C.J. Moyna & Sons, Crow River Construction and Reilly Construction Company.

Eric Gjersvik opened the four (4) bids submitted for the infrastructure of the Agri-Business Park. The bids submitted were as follows:

C. J. Moyna & Sons - \$2,655,922.00
Crow River Construction - \$1,884,290.00
Reilly Construction Company - \$1,777,000.00
Diversified Infrastruction Services - \$1,899,227.15

ISG will enter all the figures into a bid tabulation to confirm the accuracy of the bids. The information will be ready for the Board of Supervisors to receive and take action on the bids at 9:15 a.m. on Monday June 3, 2019.

Discussion was then held regarding the easements on lands south of the Agri-Business park for storm water pipe to be installed.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to direct Supervisor Kluss to contact the landowners and negotiate terms for drainage easements for the installation of storm water pipe south of the Agri-Business Park. Motion carries.
