

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

Imposition of a Local Emergency Medical Services Property Tax

Tuesday, August 7, 2018

I, Betty Ellis, Commissioner of Elections in Wright County, Iowa, do hereby proclaim that the Special Election in Wright County, Iowa will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018, from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Central Standard Time. All qualified electors will vote on the following ballot:

VOTING PRECINCTS: Voting precincts will be the same as where you voted for the General/Primary Elections.

1. The first precinct called “**Belmond**” in Wright County which consists of all of Belmond, Pleasant, and Iowa Townships, including all of the City of Belmond and City of Rowan will vote in the Belmond City Hall, 112 2nd Ave. NE. Belmond, IA.
2. The second precinct called “**Clarion**” in Wright County which consists of all the incorporated area of the City of Clarion will vote in the Courthouse Basement, 115 N. Main Street. And the “**Big 6 Townships**” in Wright County consisting of the unincorporated areas of Norway, Lake, Lincoln, Grant, Dayton, and Wall Lake will vote also at the Courthouse Basement, 115 N. Main Street, Clarion, IA.
3. The third precinct called “**Dows**” in Wright County which consists of all of Blaine and Vernon Township including all of the incorporated area of the City of Galt and that portion of the incorporated area of the City of Dows lying in Wright County will vote in the Dows Convention Center/City Hall, 119 E. Ellsworth, Dows, IA.
4. The fourth precinct called “**Goldfield**” in Wright County which consists of all of Boone and Liberty Township including all of the incorporated area of the City of Goldfield will vote in the Goldfield Legion Hall, 505 N. Main, Goldfield, IA.
5. The fifth precinct called “**Eagle Grove**” in Wright County which consists of all of Woolstock, Troy, and Eagle Grove Townships including all of the incorporated area of the City of Woolstock and all of the incorporated area of the City of Eagle Grove wards #1, #2, #3, and #4 will vote in the Memorial Hall, 200 South Park Ave., Eagle Grove, IA.

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Pre-registered voters who are unable to show approved ID may sign an oath of identification for an election held in 2018. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts also may be required to provide proof of residence. Any voter who cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another registered voter in the precinct who has proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved
