Michelle De La Riva, Executive Director, Community and Family Resources presented information on their programs and invited the county to support the CFR Campaign Initiative with a contribution of \$6,313.00 for 5 years to assist in funding the new facility being built in Fort Dodge. CFR Community and Family Resources provides a wide range of substance use treatment services, problem gambling, and mental health services for adults, adolescents, families, and communities. In fiscal year 2017, CFR gave services to 166 Wright County citizens. The board will consider this request during budget time.

Andy Flagge, Wright County Information Technology, presented the updated pricing and information concerning the upgrade to the phone system using the Verizon One-Talk. This upgrade will include all new phones county-wide and will increase internet connection speed. This will be put on the agenda for next week.
