Chairman Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Watne, Rasmussen, and Helgevold.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of August 27, 2018 and special meeting of August 28, 2018 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Alison Hauser with County Social Services presented the resignation letter from Alice Warner as the Mental Health Advocate and asked the board to consider appointing Kathy Erickson as the new Mental Health advocate. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to accept the resignation of Alice Warner and approve the appointment of Kathy Erickson as the new Mental Health Advocate in Wright County. Motion carries.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve the amended 28E agreement with Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center which will be adding more member counties. Motion carries unanimously.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Rasmussen to approve abatement orders for #1156 to #1163 on eligibility per Disabled Veterans Homestead credits. Motion carries.

Joe Harrah gave an update on his findings while spraying and cutting trees in drainage districts in Wright County. He explained that there are several places in the drainage ditches that need additional trees removed as they were too big for the equipment that he had with him during spraying. These trees are anywhere from 30 to 50 feet tall. He gave a copy of his presentation to Deb Lukes in the Auditor's office which marked the areas that he found. The board will meet with Mr. Harrah and drive out to view these trees.

Motion by Rasmussen and second by Watne to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
