Chairman Rasmussen called the regular meeting of the Wright County Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Watne, Helgevold, and Rasmussen.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of October 27, 2014 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Peggy Schluttenhofer, Wright County Treasurer, presented a request to assign a county held tax sale certificate to Eagle Grove Community Development Corp. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve the assigning of the county held tax sale certificate #2014-14503 to Eagle Grove CDC. Motion carries with Helgevold abstaining.

Dwight Reiland, Wright County Recorder, presented a name for a new hire in the Records office. It was approved to start her at \$27,500.00 with a review after a couple of months. A name will not be released until the offer to hire is made, pre-employment physical and background check is completed.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, presented the pay estimate for the 150<sup>th</sup> Street paving project in Section #36 of Belmond Twp. South side of Belmond. The engineers estimated cost is \$268,988.00. There are several road projects in the county that the Engineer would like to get done soon. Some mentioned were R65, which has been the detour route for Hwy 69 State bridge project, R65 going south out of Rowan, and R45 from Hwy 3 to the T-intersection going to Lake Cornelia. There are also several smaller bridges that are local cost (not Farm to Market expense) that also need to be considered. Supervisor Watne stated that we have gathered some good information and we need to look into what is the best use of taxpayer dollars. The board will be in contact with General Manager at Max Yield to discuss their future plans for the facility and this will be put back on the agenda at a later date.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Watne to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
