Chairman Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 8:00 a.m. Members present were Maasdam, Beenken, Amdahl, and Helgevold with Watne absent.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of April 16, 2012 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

A resident of the Lake Cornelia area met during open forum to discuss the current animal control ordinance for Lake Cornelia. He has a concern about not allowing the use of an electric fence, be it above ground or below ground, to keep your pet contained. His yard opens up to the Lake and he did not want his yard fenced in with a chain link fence because he wanted open view of the lake from his home. The board of supervisors will work on an amendment to the ordinance and hold three readings to make a possible change in allowing electric fences for containment.

Supervisor Watne joined the meeting.

Don Reffer with B & W Control Specialist came to give an estimate on the cost of spraying the drainage ditches for brush & tree control. This years' estimate was \$38,000. The drainage ditches are currently on a three year rotation for tree & brush control.

Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Watne to approve the contract with B & W Brush Control Specialties for the control of trees and brush in the county drainage districts. Motion carries unanimously.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer presented the Lock Out/Tag Out safety policy. Motion by Beenken and seconded by Watne to approve the Lock Out/Tag Out Safety Policy for Wright County. Motion carries.

Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Beenken to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
