

June 4, 2012

Chairman Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Watne, Amdahl, Maasdam, and Helgevold with Beenken absent.

Minutes of the May 29, 2012 regular board meeting were read and approved.

Approve claims for payment.

During open forum, Mary-Louise Burt presented a petition concerning the permit application on Bergamot Farms, Frohling site. In summary, this petition states that they oppose large-scale, corporate-backed factory farms because they pollute air and water, threaten our health, lower the value of homes and farmsteads, deplete county revenues, decrease the economic viability of the towns, and run family farmers out of business. This petition was received by the board.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer presented the project plans for the RM2170 (605)-9D-99 located on 255<sup>th</sup> Street on the north side of Eagle Grove. The project is designed for 1,885 feet from Hwy 17 to Wright Avenue. This project will be an R.I.S.E. Grant and will be paid 50% with grant funds, 25% from City of Eagle Grove and 25% paid by County. It is targeted to be completed yet this fall. Motion by Watne and seconded by Maasdam to approve the plans for RM2170 (605)-9D-99 and have the board sign. Motion carries.

Motion by Maasdam and seconded by Amdahl to approve the fireworks permits for Lake Cornelia Improvement Association. Motion carries.

Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Watne to approve First Citizens National Bank to use the courthouse lawn for Ridiculous day on July 27<sup>th</sup> for serving a meal. Motion carries.

Held discussion on the letter from the Department of Natural Resources on the notice of intent to issue a permit to Bergamot Farms, Frohling Site. There is a 14 day time period to request a hearing. It was the consensus of the board to not file for a hearing.

It was brought to the attention of the board that the moratorium on doing repairs to drainage ditches concerning the nesting season has been lifted; however, the landowner must receive a waiver from the FSA office.

Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Maasdam to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
