Karl Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were: Beenken, Watne, Maasdam, and Helgevold with Amdahl absent.

Minutes of the previous August 20, 2012 regular meeting were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Maasdam to reject the bid on the 1988 Chevy 3500 pickup truck of \$250.00. In consideration that the truck has value to the secondary roads department, this truck will now be put back into use with the Secondary Roads department.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Beenken to appoint Jon Ahrendsen, MD as the Wright County Medical Examiner. Also, Deputy Medical Examiners of: Charles Brindle, MD; Dennis Colby, DO; Ryan Coppola, DO; Tim Nagel, MD; Dustin Smith, MD; Amanda Tew, DO; Michael Whitters, DO. and Medical Examiner Investigator of Vinny Frank, PAC. Motion carries unanimously.

Tim Wilaby with Juvenile Court Services met with the board to discuss office space for an officer to conduct intakes and meet with kids on probation. Kristine Timmerman, Juvenile Court Officer, spends a couple days a week in Wright County and would like an office to be able to conduct business. The Supervisors will discuss options with the custodian and County Attorney.

Taylor Roll, Wright County Assistant Engineer, presented the final plans for Bridge #35, located in Troy Township, Section 16. This bridge will be twin 10' box culverts on Davis Avenue. This will be paid with county TIF funds. Motion by Watne and seconded by Maasdam to approve plans for Project #L-061659—73-99. Motion carries.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Beenken to approve the four month extension for the completion date on Big 4, DD #45 for tree removal due to a burn ban currently in effect and approve the request for tile and washout repair along the ditch in Hardin County. Motion carries unanimously.

Renee Von Bokern with Von Bokern Associates, Inc. presented changes to the Sheriff union contract of which was agreed on at last Monday's meeting with the Sheriffs deputies and Jailers. The board approved the changes.

Motion by Beenken and seconded by Watne to approve the new adjusted wages as per the union contract and adjustment made to hours worked in sheriff & jail department. Motion carries.
