Chairman Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were: Watne, Beenken, Amdahl, Maasdam, and Helgevold.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of October 1, 2012 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, presented Title VI of the Civil Rights Act agreement concerning non-discrimination in the workplace. Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Beenken to approve the Title VI Non-Discrimination Agreement with Iowa Department of Transportation and Wright County. Motion carries.

Clemons handed out information a Historic Bridge in the county. There is a historic Warren Pony Truss bridge that was constructed in 1912. It is 128 feet long and has been closed on Buchanan Avenue over the Boone River. Clemons stated that this is a Wright County historic bridge and if it is to be sold or donated to someone that the bridge would need to remain as a historic structure all in one piece. Supervisor Maasdam will contact the museum to see if they would like the bridge.

Shari Plagge, Wright County Assessor, presented the family farm applications that have been received as of last Friday. Motion by Watne and seconded by Beenken to accept the family farm credit applications as presented and disapprove the list that do not qualify as per the Iowa Code. Motion carries.

Karl Helgevold presented a letter from the Wright County Attorney concerning a donation from First Citizen National Bank. Motion by Watne and seconded by Amdahl to receive the generous donation of the existing First Citizen National Bank building on First Avenue NW. Motion carries unanimously.

Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Maasdam to approve Abatement order #1076. Motion carries.

Motion by Watne and seconded Beenken to approve the suspension order #1077. Motion carries with Maasdam and Helgevold voting nay.

Steve Soma, First Gabrielson Agency, and Fred Dolezal, ICAP, presented to the board a cumulative reserve check for the County dividends to ICAP of \$10,409.10. Wright County is a member of Iowa Communities Assurance Pool.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Beenken to approve and sign the engagement letter from Hogan Hanson for the GAAP report. Motion carries.

Motion by Amdahl and seconded Beenken to receive the quarterly revenue report from the Wright County Sheriff. Motion carries.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Amdahl to receive the quarterly revenue report from the Wright County Auditor. Motion carries.

Motion by Beenken and seconded by Amdahl to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
