Chairman Helgevold called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were: Watne, Beenken, Amdahl, Maasdam, and Helgevold.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of October 22, 2012 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, presented an amendment to the entrance policy to include the use of dual wall plastic pipe in the right of way. Motion by Watne and seconded by Maasdam to approve the amended policy to include plastic pipe. Motion carries.

Shari Plagge, Wright County Assessor, presented the Family Farm applications for the board to approve and/or deny those that do not meet the requirements. Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Maasdam to follow the recommendation of the County Assessor and have the chairman sign. Motion carries unanimously.

Dwight Reiland, Wright County Recorder, met with the board to give update on the open job position in his office.

Mick Tagesen with Elderbridge Agency on Aging presented the annual report and gave an update on the programs that they offer. Tagesen requested funding for 2013-2014 fiscal year in the amount of matching funds of \$9,595.80. Elderbridge Agency on Aging, a private nonprofit organization, serves the needs of older Iowans 60 years and older and their families.

Brad Leckrone, MH/DD Director, presented the new 28E amended agreement from County Social Services. This new agreement will be adding another county to this organization. There was then a motion by Watne and seconded by Amdahl to approve the amended 28E agreement with the addition of Fayette County in the County Social Services group. Motion carries unanimously.

Leckrone gave an update on the County Social Services meeting from last week.

Leckrone and Linda Klehm, Public Health Administrator, came to the board to discuss the cost associated to the future move of the Mental Health staff and Veterans Affairs office to the new building. Also discussed was the effect on the budget of the Public health department.

Motion by Amdahl and seconded by Beenken to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
