

January 7, 2013

Supervisor Watne called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Watne and Helgevold with Rasmussen absent.

Minute of the previous regular meeting of January 2, 2013 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Supervisor Watne wished to give Leroy Babcock a big thank you for his years of service to Wright County with serving as a Commissioner on the Veterans Affairs Commission since October 1983. His service has been truly appreciated.

Held the public hearing on the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation plan. Shirley Helgevold with MIDAS Council of Governments presented the 459 page draft plan. The county section starts at page 405. There will be some small changes and then submitted to the state for review.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Watne to approve Resolution 2013-05 approving review of the Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation plan. By roll call vote: Ayes – Helgevold and Watne; nays – none with Rasmussen absent. Resolution 2013-05 duly passes and reads as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE WRIGHT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTING A MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR WRIGHT COUNTY, IA.

WHEREAS, the Wright County Board of Supervisors has authorized the development of a Hazard Mitigation Plan for Wright County, Iowa; and,

WHEREAS, this plan will be the guidance regarding future mitigation actions; and,

WHEREAS, updates to the plan will be made after plan adoption, as required by IHSEM/FEMA.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wright County Board of Supervisors; hereby adopts the Wright County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan contingent upon committee recommendation and City Council adoption by the Cities of Dows, Rowan, Galt, Belmond, Clarion, Goldfield, Eagle Grove, and Woolstock.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 7th day of January, 2013.

Held discussion of the Flood Plain Maps. Need to adopt the maps and approve an ordinance prior to February 20, 2013.

Held the public hearing on the Wright County Comprehensive Plan. Yale Schutt, Wright County Planning and Zoning, gave some background on the meaning of the Comprehensive Plan. Carrisa Miller with MIDAS also gave information on who all gave input on this plan.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Watne to approve Resolution 2013-06 on adopting a comprehensive plan. By roll call vote: Ayes – Helgevold and Watne; nays – none with Rasmussen absent. Resolution 2013-06 duly passes and reads as follows:
