Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, discussed with the board the Iowa DOT Hwy 17 Detour agreement. He told the board the projected detour would take place from September 15, 2014 through September 22, 2014. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve the Iowa DOT Hwy 17 Detour agreement. Motion carries.

Brad Hicks, Wright County Economic Development Director, gave an update on the Clarion Housing project. He explained that MIDAS and Maxfield Research could complete a Wright County Housing Study. He also stated that there were parties that were willing to contribute to the study. The board instructed Hicks to continue working on this project and bring a final figure for what remains to be paid and action would be taken at that time.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve the quarterly revenue report received from the Wright County Sheriff. Motion carries.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Helgevold to approve the quarterly revenue report received from the Wright County Auditor. Motion carries.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the Canvass of Votes for the Belmond-Klemme Physical Plant & Equipment Levy Special Election that was held on April 1, 2014. Motion carries.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Watne to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
