Chairman Watne called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Watne, Helgevold, and Rasmussen.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of April 18, 2016 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Larry Harrah presented a quote for Drainage Ditch tree spraying/removal. The county contracts the spraying/cutting of the trees in the ditches on a three year rotation. Last year the county used both B & W Brush Control and Wright County Ag LLC. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve the bid on 17 ditches in the amount of \$42,550.00. Motion carries.

Becky Phipps, Amy Lohmeier, and Terese Price met with the board to present the Proclamation for Sexual Assault Awareness month. This proclamation is to advocate for education, survivor support, and speaking out against harmful attitudes toward assault. Phipps also introduced members of the S.A.R.T. which is the Sexual Assault Response Team here in Wright County. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve and sign the Proclamation as presented. Motion carries.

The board addressed a Private Tile hearing for landowners within DD #131. Brian Wagner requested that he have access to the main tile at station 205 crossing into his neighbors land.

Gary Robb, adjacent landowner, said that land is draining into the tile already. Robb stated that he wants Wagner to follow the fence line and hook into the tile at the south fence line of his property. Wagner said that tiling that distance would cause him to have to install much more tile than necessary.

This private tile hearing will be continued to May 2, 2016 at 10:15 a.m. for landowners to gather more information.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
