Chairman Helgevold called the special meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 8:30 a.m. Members present were Watne, Rasmussen, and Helgevold.

The special meeting was called to review the Slough Bill applications as presented by the NRCS after acres being reviewed were questioned. The Board of Supervisors approve the maximum of 3,000 acres to be allowed for the property tax exemption. The NRCS reviewed about one-third of the applications for possible discrepancies. There were about 224 acres that no longer meet the slough bill requirements. There was then a motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve the slough bill applications as presented. Motion carries.

Assessor Plagge will present to the board of review the acres not eligible and letters will be sent out to those landowners.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to adjourn the special meeting. Motion carries.
