Chairman Rasmussen called the regular meeting of the Wright County Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Rasmussen, Watne, and Helgevold.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of December 1, 2014 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Watne to appoint Courtney Stewart as the alternate to Mid-Iowa Growth Partnership Board of Directors. Motion carries.

Peggy Schluttenhofer, Wright County Treasurer, presented a county held tax certificate. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Watne to approve signing over a county held tax certificate #2013-13504; a parcel located in the City of Clarion for \$56.00 plus fees. Motion carries unanimously.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Helgevold to approve the change order #1 for DD No. 33. Motion carries unanimously.

In open forum, Bill Drury requested to have the board review the letter presented by the Wright Soil & Water Conservation District dated December 3, 2014. They have a concern about a stockpile of chicken litter in Vernon Township, Section 14. The concern is the soil type located in this area contains a lot of sand and gravel. There is a concern about leaching into the groundwater. The board will discuss this with the Company in control of the chicken litter and possibly work with DNR and IDALS about the law in stockpiling.

Supervisor Watne presented the Community and Family Resources and the Richmond Center annual financial report to place on file.

Members of the Wright County Library Association met with the board to give an update on their programs in Wright County at their individual libraries. Kevin Hadley, Trustee of Rowan Library presented an overall update. This year they would like to request \$130,230.00 which is a 5% increase from last year. This will be considered at budget time.

Motion by Watne and seconded by Helgevold to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
